Rules, Regulations

- **Parents** - are **not allowed** around the fighting areas
- **Coaches** - may be around the fighting areas, and **only discrete coaching is permitted**
- **Etiquette** - Coaches must ensure all their competitors have entered the right categories and are ready to start
- **Referee's Decision is Final** - only complaints about Administration can be considered
- **In all cases, the Chief Referee's decision is final**
- **Videos** - due to Child Protection issues anyone wanting to video all or part of the event must sign the register and wear the badge issued to them by the Organiser where it can be clearly seen by parents and officials at all times
- **First Aid** - Access to all areas must be kept clear to enable officers to see and access any location quickly.
- **Valid license and Insurance** - **There can be no exceptions** - All competitors must be able to produce a valid license and insurance at the date of the competition. They must also produce proof of age and grade
- **Running Order** - registration - 8.30 am, Start - 9.30am. Kata then Kumite
- **KATA Rules: All under 16 yrs, Ladies 'and Mens' will be scored over 2 rounds.**
 - The second round is the final 9 6,7, or 8 will go into the final depending on their scores)
 - A different Kata must be performed in the second round
 - Should a tie occur in the 1st round , a different kata must be performed as a decider. In this situation the different kata can be performed again in the final. If there is a tie in the final, then a different kata must be performed
 - All other decisions required on the day will be made by the Chief Referee
- **KUMITE Rules: All kumite events will be 1-1/2 minute rounds**
 - WKF Rules will apply for contact
 - **15 yrs and below** - All hand and kicking techniques to head, face & neck must have absolute control; should a glove or foot touch the target, the referee will not award a score.
 - **16 - 17 yrs** - Kicking techniques to the head, face & neck are allowed to make light skin contact only
 - Any techniques which causes injury, no matter how slight will be warned or penalised
 - **18 yrs and above** - Touch contact to the face, head and neck is allowed. If contact is too strong a warning or penalty will be awarded
- **All competitors must wear protective equipment this means;**
 - Hand mitts (red or blue)
 - Gum shields are compulsory
 - Groin guard
 - Shin or shin instep protectors are optional up to 13 yrs and compulsory 14 yrs and above as per WKF rules
- **Girls and Ladies** - It is recommended you wear chest protectors
- **All competitors should provide their own red and blue belts**
