

EKF Sessions

For parents attending EKF training sessions, selections and Championships

Parents/Guardians have the right to:

- Know their child is safe.
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to their children.
- Be informed if their child is injured.
- Everyone should be respectful to the other athletes, spectators, coaches.
- Everyone should respect the coach's decisions when a selection session.

Staff and officers of the EKF will not tolerate any abuse towards athletes, parents or coaches.

Any form of abuse towards an official of the EKF will not be tolerated.

Please note the EKF have a social media policy which all athletes are to follow.

Any persons bringing the EKF into disrepute during or after an EKF session could be excluded from further EKF Sessions.

Any misdemeanours and breach of these rules will be dealt with immediately by an English Karate Federation official. Persistent concerns or breaches will result in the parent/guardian being asked not to attend sessions if their attendance is detrimental to the child's welfare. The ultimate action should a parent/guardian continue to breach these rules may mean the English Karate Federation officials regrettably asking the child to leave the session.
